### Phase 3

#### Individual Planning and Highly Intensive Support Strategies for Children with Exceptional Needs

- Additional strategies for supporting children with trauma backgrounds, disability or problem behaviour:
  - Teaching self-regulation, and including sensory supports
  - Social skills instruction for children with self-regulation needs, social difficulties and disability. Specific strategies including social skills curriculum and stay, play, talk strategy (Tier 2)
  - Highly intensive individual support planning (Tier 3) utilising the Prevent, Teach, Reinforce structure for young children, for children at risk of exclusion

If you have not been able to attend previous sessions, you are still more than welcome, and will benefit from the Phase 3 training.
