Online Tier 3 Team Training Professional Learning for Schools

Dr Sharonne Telfer and Jennifer Payne from Rypple will be providing training to school-based teams to implement School Wide Positive Behavioural Interventions and Supports (SW-PBIS) Tier 3 (supports for students who need highly individualised, intensive supports to be successful). This training is offered online in 2022

Tier 3 training is for schools who are already implementing Tier 1, and preferably Tier 2, and would like to add some more intensive supports for around 1 - 5% of their students.

What would it look like if we did decide to do SW-PBIS?

Our 9 session, online training guides school teams through the process of designing their Tier 3 system.

- A Core Tier 3 team will attend sessions via Zoom, in which they will get the knowledge and resources to build all the Tier 3 systems over the course of one school year. Action Teams (formed around students who need Tier 3 supports) will attend five of the sessions.
- The team will get a clear action plan with tasks to complete between each training to build the systems to support all students.
- The team will also get all the resources they need to run “mini PL’s” with school staff who may be implementing Tier 3 interventions.
- During each training days the team will get a clear idea of what to do and how, to implement each of the Essential Components of SW-PBIS Tier 2. The training is focussed and interactive, with work time within training and a clear list of tasks to complete before the next session.
