The Southwest PBS Reference Group have partnered with Rypple to bring Dr Tim Lewis back to the Southwest in June of 2023.



Data based decision-making for student outcome and fidelity of implementation.

- Schools are invited to this session co-facilitated by Dr Tim Lewis and Jennifer Payne on how to use student data for problem solving and how to collect and use fidelity assessment information.
- Schools will be shown a step-by-step process for analysing student outcome big five data and developing whole school solution plans.
- Schools are encouraged to bring their own big five data so they can use this for problem solving.

Schools will be provided with a new tool for combining up-to-date fidelity assessments (the **Tiered Fidelity Inventory** and the new **Self-Assessment Survey**) to get a combined fidelity score for each of the components of PBIS at tiers 1, 2 and 3.

Schools will then be shown how to use this data in a structured data-based decision making approach to plan additional supports for staff to increase fidelity of implementation and student impact.
